

Is your child eligible for Free School Meals?

**Have you received
your free £30

If you receive any of the following:

- **Income Support**
- **Income-based Jobseekers Allowance**
- **Income-related Employment and Support Allowance**
- **Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999**
- **the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit**
- **Child Tax Credit (provided they are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190, as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs)**
- **Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit**
- **During the initial roll out of the benefit, Universal Credit**

then, the answer could be –Yes!

If your application for 'Free School Meals' is successful, then you will receive a free £30 uniform voucher to spend at the Sewing Shop-per child, per academic year!

Remember, it is important to register for Free School Meals, even if your child is under 7 and already receiving a school meal as part of the Universal Infant Initiative. Free School Meals eligibility will help the school receive additional funding to support your child's experiences in school.
